

Book Reporting Bingo

5 points	Make a shopping list for a character from your book. Include where they will shop and 10 items they would shop for there.	Act out your favorite part of the story for your teacher.	Create a poster to advertise your book. Include the title, author, and a picture. Your poster should make other students want to read the book, too.	Create a daily schedule for one of the characters in the story based on the events of the story.	Create a jigsaw puzzle by drawing a picture of a scene from the book or the cover. Cut it apart to create a puzzle.
10 points	Choose 10 words or names that are important to the story. Make a word search puzzle with those words.	Collect or draw 5 items that relate to an important character. Write a sentence to explain why you chose each item.	Design a new cover for the story. Explain why you think your design is a good one.	Compare yourself to a character using a Venn Diagram . 	Write an acrostic poem about the story using the name of a character or place in the story. Or you could write a song or rap about the story.
15 points	Choose an important event in the story. Create a comic strip that conveys what happened.	Write a letter to an author from this theme to tell why you liked their book. Ask 2 questions to better understand the story.	Create a piece of art (sculpture, painting, drawing) to represent an event or a character from the story.	Write a letter to a character . Introduce yourself to the character. Tell the character why you want to get to know him/her better.	Collect words and images from magazines and newspapers to create a collage for your book. Include images that you feel relate to your book.
20 points	Create a timeline of important story events or a theme author's life. Include at least 5 events, the date they happened, and a picture or drawing to illustrate the event.	Write a newspaper article about an event from the story. Include who, what, when, where, why. Also, include a picture to go with your news story.	Create an interview between you and a character. Pair up with a friend to share with your teacher. You will be the T.V. interviewer, your friend will be the character.	Choose an important event or setting from the story. Make a diorama of the scene or setting. Write a paragraph telling about your event/setting.	Write a new ending for the story. Illustrate the new ending.
25 points	Explode a Moment Take a favorite line from the story. Write it down and use it as a starting point for a new story.	Choose 3 important events in the story. Tell about the events by writing diary entries from one character's perspective.	Create a map of the important settings in the story. Include as much detail from the book as you are able. Label each part of the setting with the important events that happened there.	Design a board game to go with your story. You should have a game board and pieces to play with. Include instructions to play and an explanation of how your game relates to the story.	Create a travel brochure for the setting of the story. Include places you might visit, things visitors might do, and places to sleep and eat while visiting.
